

Do you know about our shared taxi service?

The STL has 18 shared taxi routes available to commuters, linking our bus network to some sectors of Laval. There are two types of services.

Regular: Is just like a bus, follows a specific route, makes regular stops and sticks to a schedule.

On-request: After booking the taxi by phone or online, the taxi shows up at the chosen time and stop based on a predetermined schedule.

To use the shared taxi service, you will need an OPUS card with a valid fare for the bus. Transfers can be made between shared taxis and buses.

Student OPUS cards need to be renewed by October 31

Students aged 15 and over who have an OPUS card with photo ID must get a new card before the October 31 expiry date.

Why?

Because on November 1, their card will no longer be valid to load student or reduced fares.

It's important when taking the bus!

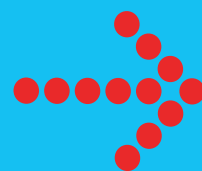
When you move toward the back of the bus:
