TRAVEL DOWNTOWN FOR FREE DURING SPRING BREAK

Enjoy downtown's many attractions by taking the 360 bus line for free during Spring Break—March 4th to 12th inclusively. Whether it is grabbing a bite to eat at the Centropolis, re-stocking your closet at the Carrefour Laval or exploring the secrets of the universe at the Cosmodôme, our buses are ready to go.

That's not all! Children also travel for free across our entire network thanks to our Family Fare policy. When you pay your fare, up to five children aged 11 and younger can travel with you for free. This policy is also effective on weekends, statutory holidays and over the summer.



A FEW SECONDS AHEAD CAN SAVE YOU SEVERAL MINUTES

Have you noticed new traffic lights with a white vertical bar? This vertical bar is called a candlestick light. It is designed to prioritize buses, taxis and other vehicles dedicated to public transport. In total, ten candlestick lights have been installed at key intersections to optimize the fluidity and punctuality of the STL's service.



This initiative is part of the *Preferential Bus Measures* (PBM) that are being implemented across Laval, including:

- 227 smart traffic lights
- 14.4 kilometres of new reserved bus lanes
- 55 bus stops and shelters that have been moved to make the network more efficient
- 6 bypass lanes

NEVER WAIT LONGER THAN 15 MINUTES ON BOULEVARD DES LAURENTIDES

The frequency of buses on this busy street is now the best in the city. Wait times for the 17, 31, 73 and 74 bus lines have a maximum wait of 15 minutes regardless of whether it is rush hour or the weekend.
