Are bypass lanes really useful?

Bypass lanes are the sections providing an additional few metres to the right of some intersections. Their main purpose is to bypass congestion on busy roads. These lanes are just as useful for the STL buses as they are for motorists. Regular drivers can use them when turning right (mandatory), and they allow our buses to pull over to the right and safely merge back into traffic, ahead of other vehicles.
